Doctor: Bailey was insane

A Southfield psychiatrist has determined that murder suspect Ronald Lloyd Bailey was legally insone at the time 13-year-old Shawn Moore of Brighton was abducted and killed last Aug. 31.
Dr. Joel Dryer's opinion contrasts sharply with the findings of the state Center for Forensic Psychiatry near Ypsilant, which issued a report July 7 saying that Bailey was neither ill nor in Ronald Lloyd sane at the time of Bailey the abduction. 


Fun in the sun


