

THE LIMOUSINE service business is highly competitive, a condition caused by operators who, Mirsud says, often are here today, gone tomorrow because of business problems or poor service.

Mifsud said he has seen industry figures showing that up to 70 percent of all limousine service operations are not properly insured in the event of an accident.

"They got into it in the first place because it looked great — easy work and good money." Miffies is not Mifsud's first business. Five years ago, he, a brother and a sister bought Miffies Forklift Industries in Detroit from their father. Mifsud left the business to start the limousine service last year.
