Get emergency information on cable tv

While the industry's main intent is to provide entertainment and programming services to your home, it also has the technology capable of enhancing city services.

On Sept. 12, MetroVision of Oakland County Inc.'s general manager, Bob McCann, and chief technician, Marvin Nelson, formally turned over the Emergency Override System to the respective public safety departments of Farmington, Novi and Farmington Hills.

Accepting representatives for the cities were: Director Frank Lauboff of Farmington, Lt. G. Nelson of Novi and Inspector Eric Miller of Farmington Hills and Lark Samouellan of SWOCC.

In the case of an emergency of great magnitude, each public safety department will be able to activate a voice message that will override all television channels actively programming.

The screen will go blank and the emergency announcement will be heard only by residents who subscribe to cable television. About 19,700 households in Farmington, Novi and Farmington Hills will be able to receive such emergency information.

Residents do keep in mind that this service is supplemental to the other emergency disaster procedures already in place for each of our communities.

The system will be administered by the Southwestern Oakland Cable Commission.

Extreme caution will be observed as is customary by the top officials as they recognize that residents of
