WHITE CASTLE ROBBED

A juke gunman robbed the White Castle at 28130 Eight Mile of \$33 in cash and took \$1,400 worth of jewelry from an employee Oct. 2.

No one was injured in the 7:25 a.m. stickup.

According to a Farmington Hills police report:

A man believed to be 19 to 21 years of age approached the counter and ordered a cup of coffee. After being served, he walked around the restaurant for a short time. He then reapproached the counter, grabbed a waiter and demanded money at gunpoint. He threatened to shoot the waiter with what he said was a .357 Magnum unless his demand was met.

At this point, the waitress who filled the man's coffee order appeared from another part of the restaurant and was ordered to remove her jewelry. After receiving money and jewelry, the man fled on foot.

Police believe the gunman may have been picked up by an accomplice driving a 1978 of 1979 silver Cadillac, which was seen parked in a nearby Farmer Jack lot moments before, Detective Darnel Krause said.

KNIFE SEIZED

A knife was confiscated from a Farmington resident's car parked in the Downtown Farmington Center Oct. 1, according to a Farmington Department of Public Safety report.

The knife had a 3 1/2-inch blade. The resident told police he was carrying it for protection. The man was advised it was illegal to carry such a weapon with an "unlawful intent."
