The most abundant Michigan ap-ples are Red Delicious and Jonathon, but other popular varielles are Ida Red, Golden Delicious, McIntosh, Rome and Norther Spy.

A number of new varieties includ-ing the Empire — a cross between Red Delicious and McIntosh — are increasing in popularity, Drury said.
