Icing on the cake is a combination of 65 pounds of sugar and 80 pounds of butter and shortening.

The cake, measuring 5 feet by 2½ feet, is eight layers high on the average. It was built in multiple, varied layers. The five-layer cake for the Lansing built is a scaled-down version of the DIA cake.
