

# Novelist coming to Farmington Friday

When a judge writes a novel about the judicial system, it's a good bet he will tell it like it is. Such is the case with William Coughlin's new novel, "Her Honor."

"But that's not all. Coughlin not only gives his readers an insider's

look at the judicial process, but he does it through the eyes of a woman. Coughlin, a U.S. administrative law judge in Detroit, will autograph his new book 7-8:30 p.m. Friday, June 5, at the Little Professor Book Center in Farmington.

"Her Honor" is Coughlin's third book, following "The Twelve Apostles" and "Her Father's Daughter." The latter is being released in paperback simultaneously with his newest book.

In "Her Honor," Coughlin's main

character is Judge Kathleen Talbot, a young, beautiful circuit court judge with a controversial case on the docket.

JUDGE TALBOT'S first major case as a judge involves a mercy

killing by a police officer of a brain-dead person. The case reminds the judge of her own decision to cut off her father's life-support system.

She proceeds with the trial despite its painful reminders for her. To add to the pressures of the trial she becomes attracted to Jeremiah Mitchell, the handsome, charismatic attorney for the defense.

## New pamphlet focuses on lung health
