Schuler wins bike race

Tom Schuler may not have won in his hometown, but he scored a triumph last weekend in the city of Brotherly Love.

The 1974 Birmingham Seasholm graduate won the CoreStates U.S. Pro Bicycle Championships in Philadelphia with a time of six hours, four minutes and 43 seconds. He eclipsed the old mark of 6:22:15 set last year by Thomas Prehn.

Schuler, who finished second in the recent Mayor's Cup Nabisco race through the streets of downtown Birmingham, won the first prize of \$20,000. He beat three others to the finish line.

By winning, Schuler qualified for the world championships to be held Sept. 7 in Vienna, Austria.

The win is surprising, since Schuler, 30, is a part-time rider this year.

He is serving as more of a mana-

ger/instructor than a rider for the 7-11 racing team. He has had very few training runs beyond 100 miles. Consequently, it was quite an accomplishment for Schuler to win the 155-mile CoreStates race.

Schuler was a two-time Olympian and a national amateur team mem-

ber for 10 years before turning professional three years ago. He has been racing for 16 years.

Italian Cesare Cipollini was second in 6:44.43. American Roy Knikman was third and Danish national team member Jorgen Macussen was fourth.

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
