

5 Schools Represented On Select Squad

Anderson Leads All-Area Harriers

Speed and spirit — this characterizes the seven boys who have been named by the Overland coaches to the All-Area Cross-Country team. The young harriers were chosen for the honor by prep cross-country mentors in Westland, Garden City, Plymouth, Livonia, Farmington and Redford Township.

Of the seven members on the select squad, four are seniors and three are juniors. Each of the youths qualified for the state finals.

Those named to the team are:

Don Anderson, Garden City West senior; Dennis Kurtis, Livonia Churchill junior; Steve Basler, Thurston junior; Steve Hatton, Redford Union senior; and three members of the fine Farmington High squad: John Donahoe, senior; Nick Burton, junior, and Kim Hildebrandt, senior.

If there has to be a leader on this blue-ribbon squad, then that designation must be pinned on Anderson, who outran all his local competition and placed fifth in the State Class A finals.

The speedy, durable West runner won his state regional meet and the Schoolcraft Invitational, which annually pits the best harriers in west-

ern Wayne County and southeastern Oakland County.

Anderson made his all-conference team and, proving that area coaches were not

the only ones who valued his talent, he also was named to a spot on the Class A All-State squad.

In addition, Anderson is

only member of this year's select group to repeat from last year's All-Area contingent.

Kurtis, of Livonia Church-

ill, also proved his speed and stamina in the long-distance races.

HE PLACED third in the state Class A regional, captured his league's first-place trophy and won the Redford Union Invitational.

He was also named to a spot on his all-conference squad.

Donahoe, of Farmington, scored high individually and served well collectively to help his team win a host of invitational and dual meets.

He finished second in the Inter-Lakes Conference meet, second in the Class A regionals and helped his mates to victory in the Oakland, Schoolcraft and Redford Union Invitationals, plus league and regional meets.

Donahoe was also named to his all-league team. Also helping to make Farmington one of the strongest cross-country teams in the state was Burton.

He ran sixth in the Inter-Lakes Conference meet, eighth in the Schoolcraft Invitational and earned a spot on his all-league team.

Basler, of Thurston, is another who makes the All-Area team.

He ran 12th in the State Class A regional, was second in the conference meet and made his all-league squad.

HATTON, of Redford Union, wound up his prep cross-country days in fine shape.

The RU runner scored a third in the Schoolcraft Invitational, placed third in the conference match and won a place on his all-league team.

Hildebrandt, was a third reason why Farmington High dominated area cross-country contests.

He finished fourth in the State Class A regional and fifth in the Schoolcraft Invitational.
