ANN ARBOR -- "You're A Good Man, Charlie Brown," New York's long-running musical romp, will come to the Mendelsohn Theatre for a six-day run, Dec. 8 to 13.

The play will be presented under the auspices of the University of Michigan Professional Theatre Program.

Performances will be given at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday evenings, and there will be matinees at 2:30 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.
