Men Workers Now Equal Women In Schooling

In 1970, for the first time, the educational level of men equal to that of women in the national labor force, according to figures reported by the National Consumer Finance Association November newsletter, FINANCE FACTS.

For both sexes, the median level of schooling was 12.4 years. This is in sharp contrast to 1940, the first year figures were available, when the median level of schooling for men was 8.6 years and 11.0 for women in the labor force.

THE GAP between formal educational attainment of men and women in the labor field has been gradually closing since World War II.

By 1952, the spread was 10.6 years for men and 12.0 years for women. The report says increasing affluence and changing attitudes made additional education attainable, and contributed to a rapid rise in educational experience for men.

Technological evolution demands of the last 20 years have also spotlighted the need for more educated workers in all fields. These demands helped to bring more female participation into the labor force. Between 1960 and 1970, 37 per cent of a 3.9 million net increase in the labor force were women, of whom 1.8 million were married.

HISTORICALLY, figures for women with less than 12 years education remained constantly low in the labor force picture. However, rates of employment for those with 12 years or more



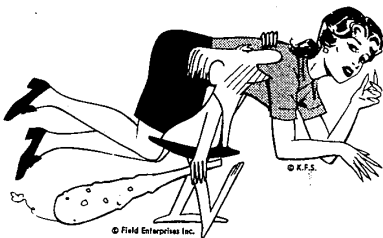


