Bosch will double size for center

Farmington Hills-based Robert Bosch Corp. is expanding its automotive research, development and applications center.

It will more than double its present size. Completion is expected later this year.

The technical center, which Bosch opened in 1983 and expanded in 1985, will be increased from 52,000 square feet to 105,000 square feet. Location is a 40-acre site at 38000 Hills Tech Drive, near the junction of I-275 and I-895.

"This expansion, combined with increased production facilities in

South Carolina, demonstrates our continuing dedication to provide U.S. automakers with complete design and engineering expertise, technical support and manufacturing capacity," said Leo Weber, president of Robert Bosch Corp. Automotive Group.

"Although initially our technical activities at Farmington Hills were directed towards basic application engineering, today a significant

amount of those activities is actual product engineering for U.S. production," Weber said. "This expansion will further extend Bosch's domestic capabilities for product engineering, testing and quality control."

The multi-million dollar project is just part of Bosch plans to invest \$15 million in expanding its U.S. operations through 1990. Also included are the addition of production capabilities for anti-lock braking system

(ABS) components and oxygen sensors, as well as construction of new aftermarket distribution centers.

In addition to ABS and oxygen sensors, Bosch is a worldwide supplier of fuel injection systems, starters, alternators, small motors, spark plugs, car radios, and other electronic, hydraulic and pneumatic components.

Robert Bosch Corp. is a wholly owned subsidiary of Robert Bosch

GmbH, Stuttgart, West Germany, which employs 150,000 people worldwide.

In addition to automotive equipment, Bosch is a worldwide name in a large number of product areas, including communications, medical equipment, industrial equipment, packaging machinery, tools, household appliances, film and video equipment as well as thermotechnology.

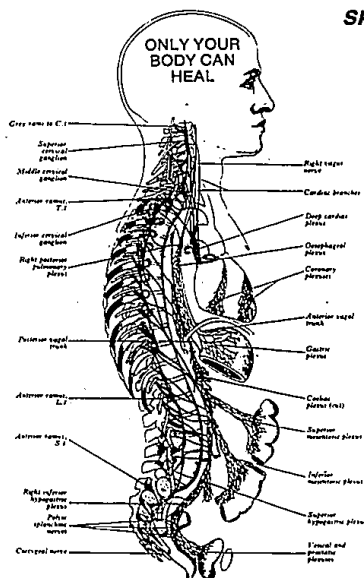
