## Revise City Dog Rules

The City of Farmington has amended its dog licensing ordinance to maintain better control over domestic dogs and to keep pace with state law changes. The city insists that all dogs, six months or older, must be licensed and wear a collar or harness at all times. Any resident who owns more than three dogs six months or older must obtain a kennel operator's license. Kennels are allowed only in general commercial (C-2) districts.

Dog owners must file for a license on or before April 1 each year. The city clerk processes dog tag applications and keep pace with state law changes. License applicants must present the clerk with a certificate of vaccination for rabies signed by an accredited veterinarian. The expiration date for the certificate cannot be earlier than Dec. 31. The fee for licenses received before April 1 is \$2 per dog and \$7 per dog after April 1.
