Fr. Peyton Visits St. John Bosco

The Catholic priest who coined the slogan, "the family that prays together stays together," will be in Observance Tuesday, Dec. 15.

The Rev. Patrick Peyton, founder of the Family Rosary Crusade of Albany, N.Y., will speak and celebrate Mass with four other clergymen at 7:30 p.m. in St. John Bosco Church, 12070 Beech Daly, Redford Township. It will be the final stop in a Detroit visit that began Dec. 6 and has taken Father Peyton to nine other Catholic establishments, including the Monastery of Blessed Sacrament in Farmington, on Monday, Dec. 7.

Concelebrating mass with the Rev. Leo N. Sheltre, pastor of St. John Bosco; the Rev. R. Burroughs, past Sunday assistant at the church; the Rev. Leo Gabriel, Franciscan, from St. Anthony Monastery, and the Rev. William Westhaven, Passionist from St. Paul of the Cross Monastery. Father Peyton is a native of Ireland whose Family Rosary Crusade has taken him all over the world to speak to audiences ranging up to a million persons. The crusade was begun in 1942 and now has 16 offices around the world, including the film-making Family Theater in Hollywood. Father Peyton's ministry also has brought out two other world-famous slogans: "The world hasn't got a prayer without yours," and "A world at prayer is a world at peace."
