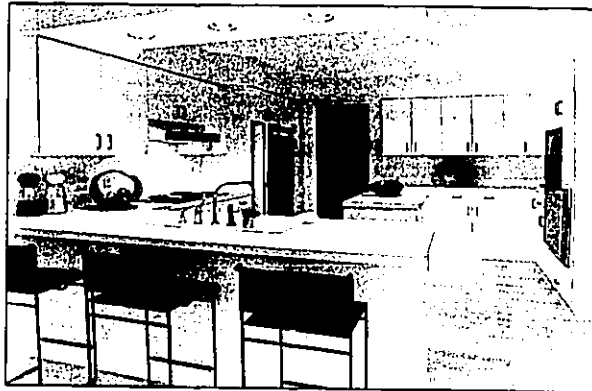
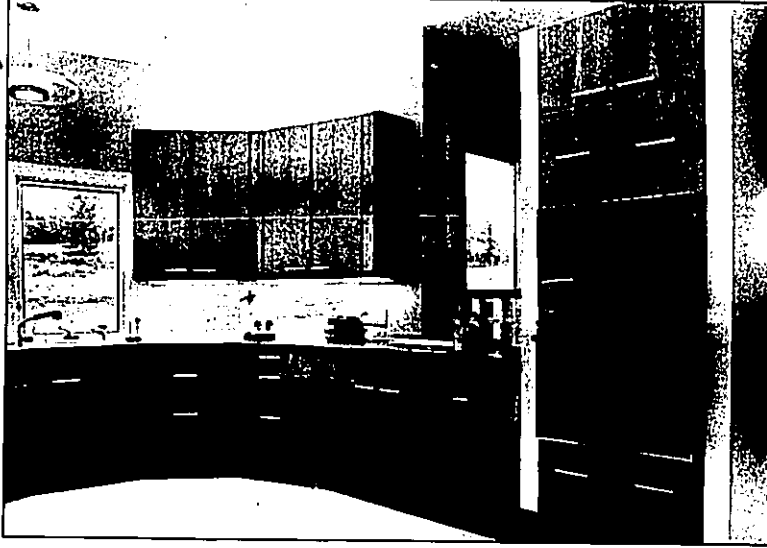


# Kitchens that stir interest
