

### cop calls

Robert Kelly, longtime attorney for the city of Farmington and Farmington Public Schools, has resigned his position with the city due to health reasons.

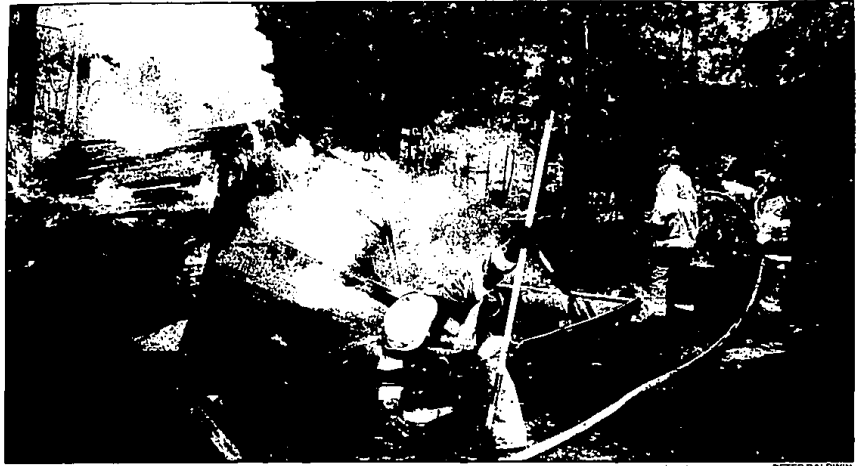
The city council accepted his resignation Aug. 15 with regret, following his more than 25 years of service. Kelly operates as a sole practitioner in downtown Farmington. His resignation is effective Sept. 1.

"His advice to council and to city staff has been unerring and always to the point," said city manager Robert Deadman. "The workload of prosecuting city ordinance cases, as well as providing legal services for the city, is such that Mr. Kelly feels compelled to relinquish these duties. I am certain that council wishes Bob Kelly a speedy recovery and good luck in his retirement."

School officials said they had also received word of Kelly's retirement, and would consider the matter at a special meeting 6:30 p.m., Tuesday, Sept. 6.
