Colorado quartet opens new season

For the 37th year, Cranbrook House in Bloomfield Hills will ring with the sound of fine chamber music when Cranbrook Music Guild begins its new season.

The Colorado String Quartet, an exciting young ensemble, will open the series at 8 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 18. After astounding the music world in 1983 by winning two prestigious competitions within 10 days—the Naumberg and Banff contests, they have become one of the most sought-after chamber groups playing today.

On Nov. 15 violinist Corey Cerovsek, a 16-year-old musical prodigy and mathematical genius, will perform. This astonishing young artist has soloed with major orchestras here and abroad and recently returned from an Australian tour.

He studies with the renowned teacher Joseph Gingold. Corey will be accompanied by pianist Katja Cerovsek, his 18-year-old sister. Critically acknowledged as an enormously gifted artist, she has been performing with symphony orchestras since age 10. She currently studies with Gyorgy Sebok.

The popular Christmas concert will feature the Battle Creek Boychoir Dec. 13. These 24 young boys practice the precise and ancient art of English choral singing. The pure, sweet sound of these unchanging young voices gives another dimension to familiar Christmas music.

Eduardo Fernandez, classical guitarist, will perform in January. The Uruguayan-born artist made a spectacular 1977 New York debut and has since been hailed in North America and Europe as one of the most brilliant guitarists of his generation.

He has the distinction of being the first guitarist signed by Decca Records since Andres Segovia.

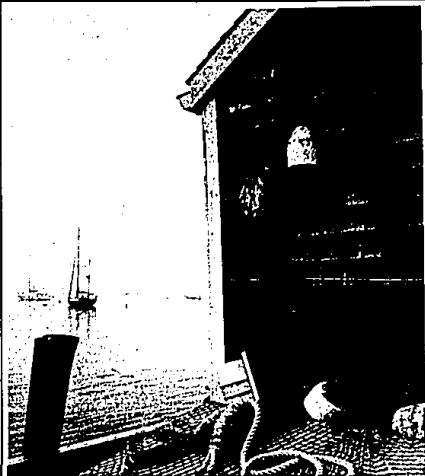
Pianist Mischa Kottler, a towering presence in the Detroit music world for more than half a century, will perform in March. The venerable Russian-born musician has enjoyed a formidable career including being musical director of WWJ Radio/TV, official Detroit Symphony Orchestra pianist, founder of a chamber music group with Joseph Gingold, the late Georges Miquele and Mischa Mischakoff, and longtime piano professor at Wayne State University, where his students included pianists Ruth Laredo and Cynthia Raim.

The April concert will showcase the winner of the Betty Brewster Scholarship. This is a yearly award given to an outstanding graduate at University of Michigan School of Music and serves to promote and support rising young music stars.

The concerts are held at Cranbrook House, a magnificent English country manor and one of the jewels of the Birmingham-Bloomfield area. This opulent Albert Kahn-designed mansion offers a perfect background for chamber music, with post-concert receptions in the Oak Room.

Cranbrook House is at 350 Lone Pine, Bloomfield Hills, across from Christ Church Cranbrook. Parking is in the church parking lot with shuttle bus service to the mansion door.

Nagler's new book introduced at show

Monte Nagler's exhibition of photographs at Somerset Mall, Oct. 6-16, will have two unusual features.

In addition to his customary large format works, taken this year, he will show a group of small photographs done in a process that he has been refining for several months. They are 4-by-5-inch contact prints which he makes using the 4-by-5-inch negative and working directly on light sensitized 140 pound watercolor paper.

Nagler will also introduce his book, "How to Improve Your Photo-

graphic Vision," just published. It is available in soft cover as well as limited edition hardbound. The hard-cover, complete with slipcase, was printed in an edition of 100 and will come with an original print.

Nagler's new large format works were done on trips to Newfoundland, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick in the east and Lake Tahoe to the Pacific in the west.

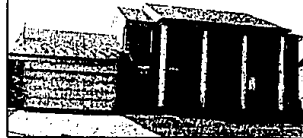

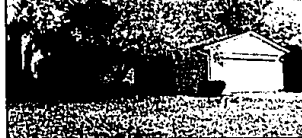
