# Counselors: Plan for retirement

If you work an average of 40 hours a week, you will suddenly find yourself with 2,000 extra hours of free time per year when you retire. Perhaps you think you'll pass the time by aleeping in, playing golf and taking those long vacations you've been looking forward to. But retirement planning counselors advise people to think seriously about their retirement expectations long before that last day on the job.

"People often don't ask themselves these questions until six
months into retirement," says LarrySlaboisky, peretirement planning
services coordinator with the Quadrant Group lne. To force his clients
to consider their use of leisure time,
he asks them to use a seven-day caiendar to decide what they would do

were retired.

"This generation of people is really a phenomenon — it's the first generation of retirees. In the past, people died with their boots on," he said.
