Drugs**

Here are questions sent to the Community Commission on Drug Abuse, Post Office Box Drugs, Livonia 48151.

Q. I have found some suspicious looking material in my son's pocket. How can I find out if it is marijuana?  
MRS. X, LIVONIA

Q. Could you tell me if the enclosed capsule is a narcotic?  
L.Y., WESTLAND

A. Your Community Commission on Drug Abuse, with the cooperation of local pharmacists, the Livonia Police Department and the Michigan State Police laboratory, now provides a drug analysis service for anonymous, no-risk, no-questions-asked identification of drugs.

Samples may be left at the following neighborhood drug stores for identification: Drugland, Seven Mile at Middle Belt; Burton Hollow Drugs, Six Mile and Farmington; Arnold's, Five Mile and Levan; Dunn's Rexall, Plymouth and Cranston; Cunningham's at Wonderland; and Shepard's at Joy and Merriman in Westland.

The capsule submitted by L.Y. was methyprylon, a non-barbiturate sedative marked under the trade name of Noludar. Since it is not very popular in the illicit market, it probably came from the family medicine cabinet. Please do not send us samples through the mail. You will give the postal authorities a fit!

Q. I've read in the papers that the Livonia public schools have a drug education program. I have one child in the fifth grade, and one in the eighth, and neither have had anything. What gives?

Ask your principal. All Livonia schools have been provided with curriculum guides, and some have already started with the program. It appears to be up to each principal to decide how fast his school proceeds.

Q. How do drug users get amphetamines and barbiturates from the druggist without a doctor's prescription?  
M.E., WESTLAND

A. What makes you think that no prescription was used to get the drugs? By law, all prescription medication must be prescribed by a qualified physician. This, however, does not mean that some people will not abuse the drug by using it for purposes other than originally prescribed.

**Road Building Contracts Given**



A MENORAH, the Jewish symbol for Chanukah, is on display in six feet of bronze at Northland Shopping Center in Southfield. Two candles were lit Tuesday and one every day thereafter for eight days. Said Northland Manager Joseph Amorello: "This year we are saying that the 'Christmas spirit' knows no religious boundaries."

Road, bridge and storm sewer projects affecting 102 Livonia communities were given fresh impetus by the State Highway Commission when it accepted low bids totaling \$16.9 million on 10 highway construction projects.

Two Livonia construction firms were among those awarded contracts by the state.

The commissioners rejected all bids on deck repairs on a bridge carrying Interstate 96 over US-10 (Lodge Freeway) over 10 Mile Road in Southfield.

But the Ministrelli Construction Co., 12240 Merriman, Livonia, was awarded a \$2,985,032 contract to provide road base improvements and paving on four miles of M-102 (Eight Mile Road) between US-10 (John C. Lodge) Freeway and the west limits of Ferndale. Ministrelli was lowest of six bidders.

COMPLETION of the work is set for June 1973.

Another Livonia firm, Jay Dee Contractors, Inc., 30419 Industrial Rd., was given the job of building 1.9 miles of tunnel storm sewer from Five Mile Road south to the Rouge River at the west city limits of Livonia.

The sewer will drain storm

water from the proposed I-96 Freeway at the west limits of Livonia and also a short section of proposed Interstate 275 south of Livonia.

Jay Dee got the contract for \$2,432,969 and was lowest of six bidders.

Completion of the project is scheduled for March 1972.

Cooke Contracting Co., \$4,476,152 to construct 1.8 miles of M-153 (Ford Road) from Hawthorne Street east to near the Southfield interchange in Dearborn. Dearborn Heights and Detroit.

The job includes grading and drainage structures, utility alterations, construction of one bridge and paving.

The work is to be finished by July 1973.

MIDWEST Bridge Co., Williamston, was lowest of five bidders at \$2,576,939 to build nine-tenths mile of two-and three-lane service roads for Interstate 96 from near Inkster Road to just east of Beech-Daly.

The job is supposed to be done by November 1971.

**Medicare  
Deadline  
Is Dec. 31**

Dec. 31 is the deadline for filing Medicare medical insurance claims for medical services received from Oct. 1, 1968, through Sept. 30, 1969," reminded Sam F. Test, district manager of the Detroit-Northwest Social Security office.

"If you have Medicare medical insurance and received covered services during the period of Oct. 1, 1968, through Sept. 30, 1969, claims must be sent in before the end of this year. Be sure you don't miss the deadline as after Dec. 31, 1970, Medicare cannot pay these bills."

Anyone who needs the Medicare claim forms or needs help with a Medicare claim may call any social security office. The telephone number for the Detroit-Northwest office is 537-9310. The hours to call are between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on Monday through Friday.
