# Raiders runners-up in tourney

The championship contest of the West Bloomfield volleyball tournament offered a rematch of last year's Western Lakes Activities Association final.

And the outcome was the same, too, as Livonia Churchill rallied to defeat North Farmington 15-7, 6-15 Saturday. The Raiders had won the tournament six of the last eight years.

"It didn't surprise me that it was the two of us," North coach Sandy Lubienleck said. "There were other good teams in the tournament, but we really have a strong conference."

The Raiders, 5-1 overall, had an 11-4 lead in the first game only to see Churchill make a stunning comeback. The Chargers carried their momentum over to the second game.

"It was not so much that our play went down," Lubienleck said. "They started getting big hits from their good hitters."

"In the second game, I don't know if we got tired or what, but our passing fell apart.

"Unfortunately, it was the last game of the tournament."

North was first in its pool, defeating Bloomfield Hills Andover (15-5, 15-6) and Farmington (15-7, 15-5) in its first two matches. The Raiders finished 5-0-1 after splitting with the host team (16-14, 10-15).

In the semifinals, North knocked off highly rated Bloomfield Hills Leaker, 15-1 going into the match, after losing the first game 7-15. The Raiders bounced back with 15-11, 15-12 victories.

Vikki Seamons and Eve Clear were North's top hitters, recording 28 and 25 kills, respectively, in the tournament. Kelly Coulson was 57-of-99 serving with eight aces and 35 points. She also had 18 digs.

"She got us started in almost every game," Lubienleck said.

Courtney Knapp and Donna O'Brien also played well, and setter Debbie Weintraub had 61 assists for the day. Knapp had 24 kills and 17 digs, and O'Brien, who missed only one serve, was 80-of-90 hitting with 22 kills and had 23 digs.

"YOU'RE GOING to have games like that," she said.

# Mercy netters dealt setback

Farmington Hills Mercy's hopes for a Central Division volleyball championship were dealt a serious setback Monday night.

The Marlins fell to 2-2 in the competitive Catholic League circuit with a 16-14, 15-8 loss to visiting Harper Woods Regina.

Mercy already has lost to Livonia Ladywood and the Saddlelites, both 3-1 in the division. The Marlins are 14-8 overall.

"A lot of things can happen," Mercy coach Tim DeBello said. "But it's definitely not the situation you want to be in."

"We played pretty good volleyball. We just lost; they beat us. We missed some serves in critical situations."

One of those errors occurred in the first game with Mercy leading 15-14. A bad serve gave the ball back to the Saddlelites, and "they did what they needed to do," DeBello said.

The Marlins led 6-0 in each game, but they fell out of contention earlier in the second. Regina tied it at 8-8, and Mercy couldn't do anything after that.

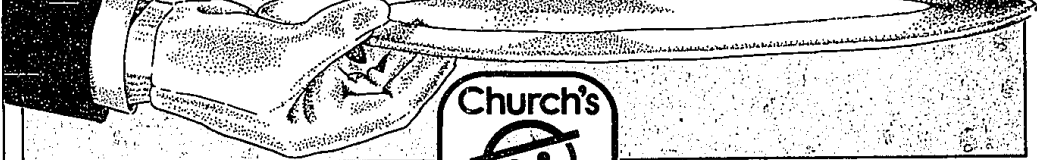
"We got the ball back two or three times, and that's when we had bad serves," DeBello said.

"We served pretty well," DeBello said, "but when we needed to have a good serve to get some momentum going we just didn't get it."
