



5 Seek 2 Posts In C'ville Race

A diversified field of five candidates, ranging from an engineer at the Chrysler Corporation to an administrator at Wayne State University and a service man with Michigan Consolidated Gas, will be seeking two positions on the Clarenceville Board of Education at the election on June 8.

Heading the list is incumbent Robert Erickson, 2045 Weyher, Livonia, who will be seeking a full term after serving for the past three years as a replacement.

The others include Sauveur DeBono, 2014 St. Francis, a service man with the Michigan Consolidated Gas; Arthur Kopelman, 20019 Maplewood, sales manager of the Seligman & Associates, Realtors; Melvin O. Kuehn, 20125 Weyher, an engineer at Chrysler Corp.; and Daniel E. Malone, a body designer at Ford Motor Co.

Here is the background of the candidates:

ROBERT ERICKSON—an administrator at Wayne State University who has served on the Clarenceville board for the past three years. He has been a resident of the district for five years, is married and the father of three children.

In seeking another term he cites three important programs he would like to see instituted in the schools. First, he favors strengthening the entire basic program of reading and writing. Second, he states that the Board of Education must examine new programs, one of which should be what he terms "pre-school" education. By this he states that the program should concentrate on four-year-olds and work with other pre-school types in order to prepare them for the regular public school program. "They must come ready to learn," he stated and he added that he wanted a program in the schools for all residents in order that Clarenceville really would have a community school.

Third, he proposes establishment of better relations and communications among administrators, faculty, teachers and students to provide a good, healthy educational climate.

ARTHUR KOPELMAN—42-year-old sales manager of Seligman & Associates, has been a resident of the district for 13 years. He is married and the father of two children, one 16 years old and another 13 years old.

Making his first attempt to gain public office of any kind, he believes the time has come to get involved, especially in school activities. As a father he says there are many important issues coming up in the near future and that he wants to do his share toward bettering the entire educational program.

If elected, he stated, he would attempt to have a stronger cooperative program with business and industry. "Only about 15% of the students are in the higher echelon and we must do something for the other 85% in the way of preparing them for life. The best way is through a strong cooperative program."

DANIEL E. MALONE—36-year-old body designer at Ford Motor Co. He is making his first attempt to gain public office.

Active in the district for the past five years, he has been president of the Grandview PTA for two years, president of the Heartstone Homeowners Association for one year and has been active in all community affairs.

The father of four children he is a graduate of the GM Institute and Ford Community College, aside from completing a specialized course in auto body designing.

"The education of my children is my responsibility," he stated, "and in looking out for their interests I can help all others. I have always been interested in things and am eager to do my part in bettering our program of education."

SAUVEUR DEBONO—a resident of the district for 14 years and most of them spent as a serviceman with the

Michigan Consolidated Gas Co. He is making the run for the Board of Education at the urging of many neighbors and friends.

This is his first venture into politics and, as the father of three children he claims the first big job facing the Board of Education is the elimination of politics from the school system.

Charging that there are some on the extreme left and others on the extreme right, he wants to foster more interest in the middle of the road.

He also charges that there is not enough discipline in the schools and he would like to foster a program to better these conditions.

MELVIN O. KUEHN—47-year-old engineer at the Chrysler Corp., is making his third attempt to gain a seat on the Board. He finished third in the 1959 race and ran again in 1961 only because there was no other opposition.

The father of three children he served on the Northwest Community College Board that established Schoolcraft College.

He has been president of the Parents Group and the Athletic Booster Club and is a member of the PTA.

He is running on a platform to provide an adequate education for all children.

"Ever since I came to Clarenceville 14 years ago," he said, "schools have been my hobby and I am eager to get involved to bring about higher standards for the children."
