## Center transports technology

THE NEW mobile training center offers on-site comprehensive instruction in full-or-half-day seminars, tailored to their client's needs to provide crucial hands-on experience.

## 9-screen theater at site of drive-in

A nine-screen movie theater, featuring Dolby Stereo Sound, will be part of the new West River Centre shopping development, former site of the Grand River Drive-In, Farmington Hills.

The announcement was made by G.R. Associates Limited Partnership of Southfield, general partner Fred Goldberg, United Artists Theatre Circuit and Taubman Theatres will build the theater complex.

Phase II will have 100,000 square feet.
