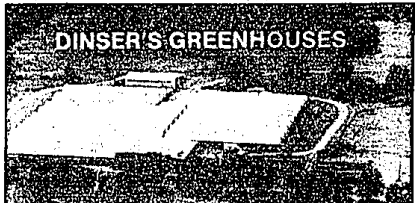
DEAN'S LIST
