

Henry Miller has put together quite a streak for Wayne State's baseball team.

The sophomore righthanded pitcher from Westland (Livonia Franklin) won three straight games entering last weekend's two double-headers with Oakland University.

In that streak Miller had a span of 17 consecutive scoreless innings, including a 1-0 eight-inning shutout of Saginaw Valley State.

For the season, Miller had a 4-3 win-loss record with one save in 43 1/3 innings. He allowed 38 hits, 31 walks and 11 earned runs, striking out 58, and had a 2.29 earned run average for the 17-21-3 Tartars.

John AbuNassar, a senior at Lake Forest College from Farmington Hills, set a single-game record for the Foresters' lacrosse

Dennis Bushart, a junior second baseman from Redford (Union), .301, six doubles, a triple, a homer

Jeremy Krol, a freshman pitcher on Albion College's baseball team from Garden City, is sixth in the MIAA in ERA at 2.08.

Mary Hebert, a junior outfielder on Western Michigan's softball team from Garden City, was hit-

ting 227 with two doubles, a triple and the team's only home run (through April 24), and 15 RBI.

Susan Pachera, the No. 1 singles player for Albion College's women's tennis team from Livonia (Churchill), compiled a 9-5 overall match record and was 2-3 in MIAA play.

The Farmington YMCA Hydrofolis Swim Club's Ross Cipriano, Mike Elmore, Jay Jones and Dana Wood set state records in two events last month during the Michigan Masters Short-Course State Championships.

Competing in the 25-29 age group at the University of Michigan's Cushman Natatorium, the foursome swam 1:47.0 in the 100-yard medley and 1:39.4 in the 200 freestyle.

In addition, eight members of the Hydrofolis placed sixth or better in at least one individual event. Phyllis Beard was five events in the 70-74 age group, and Jones had six first places in the 25-29 bracket.

Beard won the 50 backstroke, 57.40; 100 breaststroke, 2:04.57; 50 breast, 53.78; 50 free, 41.84; and 100 free, 1:38.42. Jones won the 50 butterfly, 24.40; 200 individual medley, 2:05.18; 200 fly, 2:02.51; 100 fly, 53.30; 50 free, 22.94; and 100 IM, 56.34.
