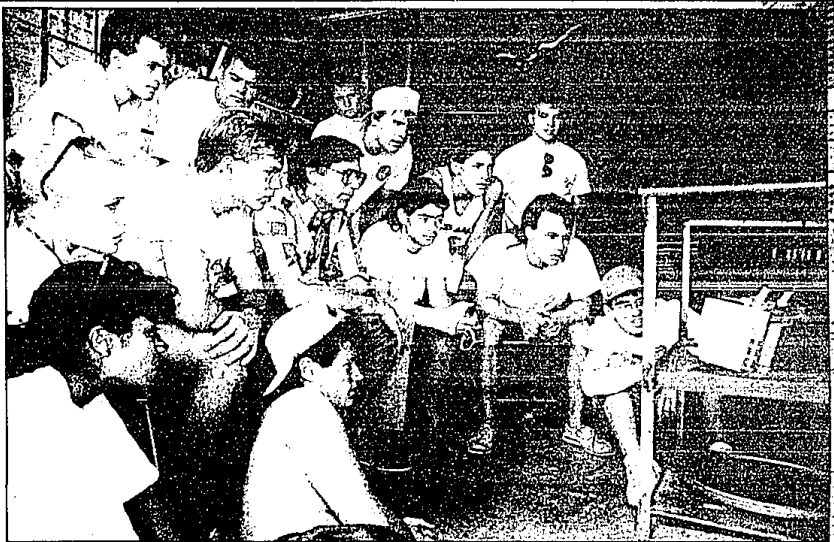
and older, \$4 for children under 10 years of age. Carry-on infants free.
