Among the delicious sampling of entrees were Pan Fried Lake Superior Whitefish with Sauce Hollandaise, Green River Smoked Trout with Roasted Sweet Red and

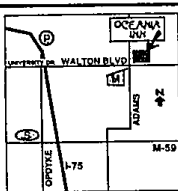

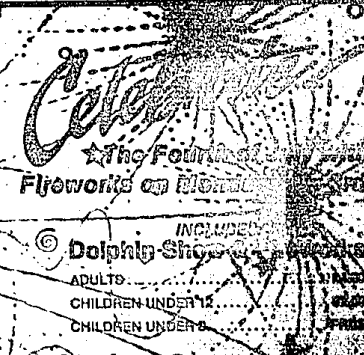
