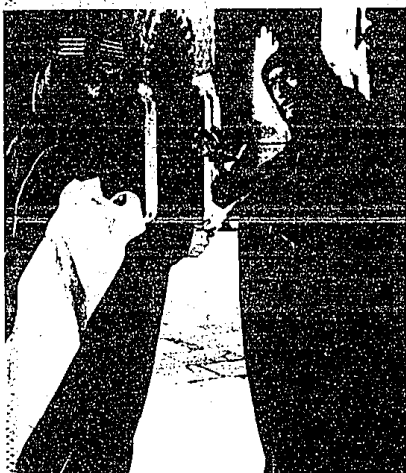

FOX THEATRE

The restored film classic "Lawrence of Arabia" will debut in Detroit on Wednesday, June 29, for a limited engagement through Sunday, July 16, at the Fox Theatre. Originally released in 1962, this film reveals the story of T.E. Lawrence, the enigmatic British hero of the Arab revolt against Turkey during World War I. Peter O'Toole, who

plays the title role, became an international star with the film's release. Showtimes are 7:15 p.m. Tuesdays-Saturdays and 2 p.m. Sundays. There will be no shows Mondays except July 3 at 2 p.m. General admission tickets, at \$10 for adults and \$7.50 for children under 16, may be purchased at the Fox Theatre box office, Joe Louis Arena box office and at the door prior to showtime. The theater will open at 6 p.m. and 1 p.m. respectively for ticketed patrons who wish to tour the Fox prior to the show. Tickets are not available through Ticketmaster.
