

Strong field may elude DRC in Michigan Mile

It appears Proper Reality will have plenty of breathing room, in-and-out of the starting gate, as a number of qualified nominees have shied away from the 41st running of the \$300,000 Michigan Mile at Ladbroke DRC.

Post-time is 5:40 p.m. Saturday, but not many had committed to the post by mid-week.

Allan Plevier, director of racing for DRC, has been scrambling all week to find a competitive field. By Saturday he hopes to bring in seven to nine other competitors.

As for Tuesday, DRC Public Relations Director Bob Raymond could confirm only "four definite," with the prohibitive favorite being Proper Reality, a 4-year-old brown colt boasting nine wins in 15 starts with more than \$1.4 million in career earnings.

The other three "definites" include Mi Selecto, a grass specialist and recent winner of the \$150,000 Dan Patch Handicap in Toronto (July 1); Present Value, a two-time winner in '89 being shipped in from Kentucky; and Air Worthy, owned by Farmington Hills cement contractor John Carlismo.

Proper Reality, bred in Florida and owned by 61-year-old Mrs. James Winn of Fort Springs, Ark., may follow in the footsteps of previous mile winners Waquoit (1987) and Last Code (1988), each of whom won in romps.

PROPER REALITY'S TRAINER Robert Holthus has been a leading trainer at three different tracks including DRC (1970-71), Oaklawn Park in Hot Springs (six times) and Hawthorne Race Course near Chicago.

Holthus has trained four different stakes winners, but calls Proper Reality "the best horse I've ever had."

The jockey, 31-year-old Dallas native Jerry Bailey is no slouch either, having been the leading jockey at Hawthorne (1976-77) along with the "Tiger" Park meeting at Calder Race Course near Miami (1977-78). He has more than 2,100 career wins earning in excess of \$40 million. In 1984 he rode Fit to Fight, who won the New York Racing Association's Handicap Triple Crown.

Rated one of the top 10 thoroughbreds in the country, Proper Reality, assigned a top weight of 126 pounds, has been on the grounds since late last month along with Air Worthy, which the veteran Carlismo calls

"the best horse I've ever owned" in 29 years.

Air Worthy recently returned (June 24) from Churchill Downs in Louisville, Ky. where he won the \$100,000 Stephen Foster Handicap, a Grade III stakes race.

A VICTORY SATURDAY by Air Worthy could make up for a blunder Carlismo made some 23 years ago.

Only a week before the 18th running of the Mile in 1966, Carlismo sold Stanilas, which went on to upset favorite Tom Rolfe for the crown.

But make no mistake, some of the country's top thoroughbreds — Seeking the Gold, Blushing John, Cryptoclearance and Private Terms — are

all safe bets to be elsewhere this Saturday.

Because of Michigan rules regarding the use of lasix, an anti-bleeding medication, a dream matchup for the 1988 Mile between Last Code and Californian Cutless Reality fell through.

This year, DRC officials are trying to persuade Simply Majestic, a speed horse with more than \$1.2 million in career earnings and holder of six track records, to make an appearance.

Coming off a third in the Massachusetts Handicap, Simply Majestic is scheduled to compete July 19 in the United Nations Handicap in Atlantic City, N.J.

AS OF WEDNESDAY, trainer John Parrisella said the chances are slim of coming to Livonia, but owner Ted Sabarese, who recently filed for bankruptcy, may have a change of heart, eyeing the \$180,000 first-place payoff.

"If we had Simply Majestic go against Proper Reality, that would be a good race," said Raymond.

But for now, some of racing's lesser-knowns — Triteamtr, Congelaur, Feeling Gallant, J.T.'s Pet, Baltic Fox and New York Seal — may be the ones filling the starting gate.
