For the second consecutive year, Daniel Passman and John Anderson found themselves traveling 1,200 miles on the highways of Michigan in a race to help the state's needy children.

Sponsored by Farmington Hills-based Little Caesars Pizza, the two-man team participated in the Michigan Association of Children's Alliances Michigan (MACA) Grand Tour

for Children.

MACA is a statewide information and action network that assists needy children and their families.

The Little Caesars race team started the engine of their 1987 Buick Grand National at noon July 21 in front of the Stroh River Place in downtown Detroit. The Grand National is a limited production car based on the rear-wheel-drive Buick

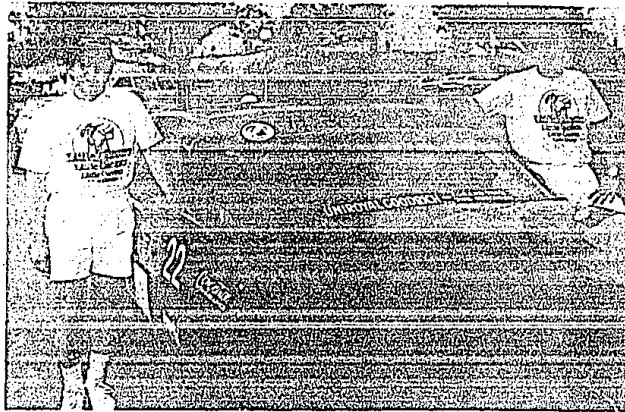
Regal model. The car and its drivers received three trophies in last year's race; one of the trophies was the "Children's Choice" award.

Entry fee from the 35 participating teams will be used to aid MACA programs aimed at providing training and support for professionals who work with children in treatment programs such as: drug abuse or dependency, suicide prevention, teenage pregnancy, non-functional families and child abuse or neglect.

Drivers participating in the 50-hour trek were judged on precise driving and navigational skills. The rally ended in Lansing at 4:30 p.m. on July 23.

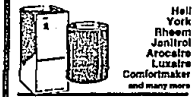
The academy is the second-largest dental organization in North America.

Mesaros is a member of the American Dental Association, the Michigan Dental Association, the Oakland County Dental Society and the R.W. Bunting Periodontal Study Club.

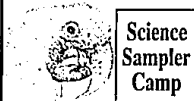
