Soapwort was brought over intentionally because of its long history of see. When the leaves are runhed in water and mixed, they produce a foamy lather. This soapy quality and its cleaning properties were known since the Middle Ages. It was brought from France and Germany



to England by friars, who planted its near their monasteries and nospitals. Textile mills used a soapwort solution to whiten fabric before it was printed. It was also used to brighten china and glass. According to one source, a solution made from scopwort leaves is used for this purpose even today. There are several other qualities of this plant which made it beneficial to man. It has a pleasant fragrance, which was used to cover up the stench of some of the English streets that had poor sanitation. Modern research has discovered that some chemicals found in scapwort are useful in treating syphilits, jaundice and liver problems. Though the plant is moderately poisonous, medieval brewers used to to help put a head on their steins of beer.


