# Evening historic church tour offered

Church history buffs who are unable to attend the First Monday of the Month Historic Church Tours will be offered a special evening tour scheduled for Wednesday, Sept. 20.

The Detroit Historical Museum's Historymobile will leave the museum at 5:30 p.m. and return around 10:30 p.m. after visiting All Saints Russian, St. John-St. Luke, St. Joseph and St. Mary churches. The \$18 ticket price for DHS members (\$20 for non-members) includes a church supper.

Advance reservations are required. To register, send your check to the Detroit Historical Society, 5401 Woodward Avenue, Detroit 48202 with your name, address and daytime telephone number. Ticket and parking for the church tour will be in 1013 to serve the small Russian colony which had arrived in Detroit around the turn of the century. The Asbury Methodist Episcopal Church, designed by H.D. Butterfield and constructed in 1901, was purchased by the congregation in 1914 and the roof-top dome, triple-barred cross and other appearances was added.

St. John's was the first German congregation in Detroit and was founded in 1833 in a carpenter shop where the Ford Auditorium now stands. The present church was designed by Julius Hess and the sanctuary was dedicated in 1874. At that time the spire was the tallest in the city. The congregation merged with St. Luke's in 1969 as St. John-St. Luke Evangelical United Church of Christ.

St. Joseph Parish was established in 1856 to care for parishioners on farms and homes "in the northeasterly direction" (along Gratiot Avenue). In 1870 construction began of a new stone church at Jay and Orleans. Architect Francis X. Himptler styled it in Gothic Revival with a tall central tower in two stages, spire and sloping side aisles.

The final stop will be at St. Mary's Catholic Church, the third oldest Roman Catholic parish in Detroit, in the area now known as Greentown. The first church was built in 1841 and the present edifice was dedicated in 1885. It was designed by 28-year-old Peter Dedericks in a composite of Pisan Romanesque and Venetian Renaissance. It remains 1,200.







