

To blanch or not to blanch

Tough, stringy, hay-like may be the words you will use to describe the vegetables you not not be the words of the words you will use to describe the vegetables you neglected to blanch before freezing fikis summer. "Blanching not only cleans and brightens vegetables but also stops the development of enzymes that destroy flavor and vitamin retention," said Sylvia Treitman of the Oakland County Cooperative Extension Service. Blanching is necessary for all vegetables which will be forzen over one month. The only exceptions would be vegetables use has onions, green peppers and herbs.

Blanching is a simple scalding of the vegetable in boiling water for a specified time, followed by immersion in ice water, before draining and packing for freezing.

Timing is crucial in developing a good product, along with several other important considerations which include the following tips:

Pre-wash, drain, sort, trim and cut vegetables.
Use one gallen of water for each pound of vegetables — use two gallons for leafly greens.
Put vegetables in wire basket and lower into boiling water — begin counting as soon as vegetable is immersed.
Immediately cool vegetables in ice water for equal amount of scalding lime.
Freeze best quality vegetables — as soon as possible after harvest and freeze as quickly as possible.
