Mill's connects bealthy, well-educated, health care providers with those in desperate need of training, new skills and improved ways of serving the sick, the poor, and the uneducated.

DRAWING ON the resources of the 16 divisions of Sisters of Mercy Health Corp. and other Mercy Health Services subsidiaries, MHS

sends skilled personnel overseas to enable local health workers in other countries to improve health services. Mercy's assistance to local health professionals abroad ranges from training in hospital administrative and management skills to clinical nursing, to bousekreping, to repairing equipment.

A few projects are different, like that of the operational cost study of the Fill School of Medicine in Suva and the medical; malpractice and quality assurance studies in Micronesia and Polymeia; both projects culminated in three-day workshops culminated in three-day workshops countries.

Projects such as the current U.S. Public Health Service-funded Al-coholism and Substance Abuse Community Care training program in the

Federated States of Micronesia are designed to have a major impact on the health care delivery system of an entire developing country.

AT TIMES, health personnel from abroad are trained in institutions here in the United States. For example, in cooperation with staff leaders at Mercywood Hospital on the Catherine McAuley Health Center campus in Ann Arbor, selected personnel from the island states of Pohnpel, Truk, Yap and Kosrae are being trained in community-based mental health and substance abuse care through a program designed specifically to fit the social, cultural, economic, and health system requirements of this newly emerging Pacific Island nation.

But MHIS services are not limited to developing nations. Requests for

assistance have also come from congregations operating hospitals in developed countries. In Perth, Australia, for example,
