

Piccolos And Flutes Featured In Concert

A program especially suitable for young people has been chosen by the Plymouth Symphony for its fourth concert of the 25th season. The concert will be given Sunday, Jan. 24, at 4 p.m., in Plymouth Central School, Main at Church streets.

The program will close with a rousing "Stars And Stripes Forever" by Sousa in which 12 piccolo players will be starred.

GUEST soloist will be Nelson Hauenstein, professor of flute, University of Michigan school of music. Mrs. Penny Fischer, a former member of the symphony who now lives in Washington, D.C. and Mrs. Louise Hauenstein.

Prof. Hauenstein will play the Stamitz Concerto for Flute and Strings in G major. He will conduct the performance of Henry Brant's "Angels and Devils," a concerto for flute and flute orchestra. Mrs. Fischer will be soloist, and a number of

Prof. Hauenstein's former students will be in the flute orchestra.

Mrs. Hauenstein will perform the piccolo solo part of Vivaldi's Concerto for Piccolo and Orchestra in C major.

ALSO ON the program will be the overture to Mozart's "Magic Flute," "Piece for Alto Flute," by Jones; Pandean Fable for Bass Flute and Orchestra by Williams, and the Suite from the ballet "The Incredible Flutist" by Piston.

Short introductory comments will be made by Conductor Wayne Dunlap before the performance.

There is no admission charge to the concert, and a nursery is provided for children between the ages of two and six years.

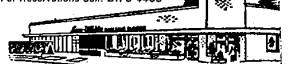
