

State's arts leaders honored

Concerned Citizens for the Arts in Michigan (CCAM) will host its fifth annual Governor's Arts Awards dinner at the Hyatt Regency in Dearborn on Monday, Nov. 13.

"This year's ceremony will be bigger and better than ever," said Judith Dow Alexander, CCAM's arts awards committee chairperson. A statewide committee of 12 people reviewed nominations and recently selected individuals and organizations to receive CCAM's 1989 Governor's Arts Awards.

THE WINNERS are:
Michigan Artist Award — Charles McGee, painter/sculptor, Detroit; Civic Leader — Paul Gannon, a musician and civic leader of Dearborn; Business Honor Roll Award — Steelcase Inc., Grand Rapids; Arts in Education Award — Cledie Taylor, teacher, Detroit; and Media Honor Roll Award — Tony Spina, photojournalist, Bloomfield Hills.

Arts Organization Awards will be presented to Bay de Noc Indian Culture Association, Gladstone; Performing Arts Department, Detroit Institute of Arts; and Muskegon Museum

of Art. James Earl Jones will receive the International Achievement Award. This award is presented annually at the ceremony to a Michiganian who has achieved international prominence in the arts.

JONES HAS achieved international acclaim during his more than 30-year career as an actor in motion pictures, television and theater. In all, Jones has appeared in more than 50 plays on and off Broadway, 30 motion pictures and 25 television shows and mini-se-

ries. On stage, Jones won a Tony Award for his performance as Troy Maxon in the Pulitzer Prize-winning play "Fences," starred as the title role in "Othello" and appeared in "King Lear," "Hamlet," "Boesman and Leni" and "Of Mice and Men." His film credits include "The Great White Hope," for which he was nominated for an Academy Award as best actor, "Coming to America" as Eddie Murphy's father, the king, "Field of Dreams," in which he portrayed a haunting Terrence Mann; and

"Dr. Strangelove," where he appeared as Lt. Jimmy Zogg.

ON TELEVISION, Jones is best known for his role as Alex Haley in the mini-series "Roots" — The Second Generation. He was part of an all-star cast when he portrayed Balhazaar in "Jesus of Nazareth," and has made guest star appearances on the series "Highway to Heaven" and "L.A. Law."

Jones is host for PBS' "Strikes Back" and "The series of classic fairy tales and fables, "Long Ago and Far Away" and has recorded for Scholastic Records.

Tickets for the Governor's Arts Awards dinner and ceremony are \$150 per person, \$1,500 for a table of 10.
