

Boy Scouts honor Headlee with Citizen Award

Richard H. Headlee, 59, chairman of Alexander Hamilton Life Insurance Company has been selected by the Clinton Valley Council of the Boy Scouts of America as recipient of its Distinguished Citizen Award.

John Farley, president of Clinton Valley Council Boy Scouts of America, said: "While Dick Headlee is a familiar name to us, most Oakland County citizens have been unaware of his leadership involvement in a wide range of business, religious and civic activities including the advisory board of the Clinton Valley Council Boy Scouts."

"A dinner and program honoring Headlee as the Oakland County Citizen-of-the Year has been scheduled

for the Pontiac Silverdome on Wednesday evening, Nov. 29.

Former Governor George Romney is chairman of the annual event that traditionally raises \$40,000 from citizen participation for Boy Scout activities in this area.

SCOUT EXECUTIVE Charlie Largent said, "Some of the noteworthy achievements considered in Headlee's selection for the Oakland County Citizen of the Year Award are:

Developing Alexander Hamilton Life Insurance Company from a failing company in 1972 to one now ranking among the top life insurance companies in North America and

employing 650 in its Farmington Hills home office.

Setting an exemplary standard for corporate volunteers by serving as president of the U.S. Jaycees (1983), chairman of Taxpayers United which passed and protects the Headlee Amendment to the Michigan Constitution (1977 to present), chairman of the Michigan State Chamber of Commerce (1980-82) and now serving on the national board of the Life Office Management Association.

Participation in government through his appointment by President Ronald Reagan to the Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board in Washington, D.C. Headlee was the

Republican nominee for Governor of Michigan in 1982.

Member of the board of directors of the Economic Club of Detroit, chairman and trustee of Oakland University, and an original supporter of the "Save Orchestra Hall Committee."

Served The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints as Bishop twice, and most recently as Regional Representative.

And, with his wife, Mary, he does their share expanding the Scouting program through nine children and 31 grandchildren. His youngest son, Howard, received his "Eagle" in 1984.

The Clinton Valley Council serves 24,000 youths and adults participating in 361 Scouting units consisting of 191 Cub Scout packs, 119 Boy Scout Troops, 13 Varsity Scout teams, 30 contemporary Explorer posts, and eight Career Awareness

posts.
