

Opera Lite Company performs 'Amahl and The Night Visitors'

The classic story of "Amahl and The Night Visitors" will come to life in the sanctuary of Nardin Park Church at 8 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 16. Originally commissioned by NBC Television in the 1950s, this work has become known and loved the world over.

This will be a first-class production, complete with costumes, props, and a full orchestra, along with an extremely talented group of singers and dancers. Performers are members of Opera Lite Company, under the artistic direction of David Pulice, with starring roles being played by Chris Jones, Barbara Youngerman, Karl Schmidt, and Carl Clemen-

denning. The orchestra is led by James Hobmeyer, conductor of both the Rochester and Lake St. Clair Orchestras, who has worked with artists connected to the Meadowbrook, Bonita, and Hipperty Theaters.

Prior to the performance of "Amahl," "Les Flutes Douces," a Renaissance instrumental ensemble, will provide several musical selections. Under the direction of Faith Gardner, this talented group has performed at the Renaissance Festival and is well-known in the music community. Using medieval and renaissance replica instruments, their performance will set the mood for the rest of the evening's events.

An added feature of the program will be the presentation of organ music based upon the "Noels" of the early French composer, Claude Daquin. Calvin Rookus, minister of music at Nardin Park, will be at the organ console.

At the conclusion of the musical performances, guests are invited to a gala reception in the church's fellowship hall. Festive decor and finger desserts will be offered.


