

Ervin Nichols To Be Soloist

New Orchestra Debuts

REDFORD The Detroit Symphony Youth Orchestra will present its debut concert Sunday, Jan. 31, at 3:30 p.m., in Ford Auditorium, Detroit. The new orchestra includes young musicians from Farmington, Livonia and Southfield. Unreserved tickets at \$1 are available for the concert from the Ford Auditorium box office and at all Hudson's and Grinnell's stores. Proceeds from the concert will benefit the Detroit Symphony Youth Orchestra Scholarship Fund, which is available to qualified musicians outside of the Youth Orchestra as well as orchestra members.

BETTY LANE will be the soprano soloist in "Debut de jour" from "Louise," "Vissi d'Arte" from "Tosca" and the Negro spiritual "Witness." The orchestra will perform "Toccata" by Frescobaldi, movements II and IV from Sibelius' Symphony No. 1 in E minor, "Noel for Brass" by Riegger and the ballet suite "Panambi" by Ginastera.

The Youth Orchestra was formed last fall in conjunction with a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts. Local musicians attending high school or college from throughout the metropolitan area were invited to audition for positions within the orchestra, the final selections being made by Paul Freeman, the conductor.

More than 400 young people applied, and 119 members were chosen. The orchestra will serve as a training ground for talented young musicians and prospective symphony musicians.
