The most far reaching soil study ever taken in Wayne County is to get started this spring.

The survey, approved by the Wayne County Board of Commissioners, will require approximately three years, according to Gerald E. Waren, chairman of the County Planning Commission.

Details of the plan were worked out Thursday after moon in Belleville at the annual meeting of the Wayne County Soil Conservation District, where it was learned that the study will touch on most every one of the Wayne County's 623 square miles.
