## Wrong number State investigating cellular phone rates

The Michigan Attorney General's office is Investigating several com-plants, including one by a Birming-ham doctor, agoinst Ameritech Mo-bile Communications for tripling its cellular phone economy rates. "These people are playing games with these rates," said Dr. George Kadian of Birmingham. "It was false advertising."

Kadian of Difficulture advertising." Ameritech Communications Man-ager Lisa Elian said the rate in-crease is entirely legal according to the terms of the service contract all the terms of the service contract all

the terms of the service contract all existences sign. Kadian said he signed eight of his employees up for six months of cell-ular service last December when the rate was 37.50 per month. He found out last month though that Ameri-tech raised the economy rate to \$21.95 a month effective Feb, 19.

THEY TOLD US there was noth-"THEY TOLD US there was noth-ing binding occommy cocommy rate," he said. "They told us, "Read your contract. There's nothing bind-ing us to that six-month period." Kadlan said be was locked into the six-month commitment, and he was under the impression that \$7.50 was to be the rate for six months.

to be the rate for six month. Since he complained, Kadian soid Ameritech has agreed to continue charjing his employees the lower rate [77,30]. Michingan Attorney Goneral spokesman Chris DeWitt sald a re-view is pending on complaints against Ameritech. He said Attorney General Frank Kelley is expected to make a deci-sion within two weeks. "There have been a number of complaints in the last six to eight weeks," DeWitt sald

Kadlan said in a letter to Kelley, "We (eel very strongly that we were manipulated We would appreciate the involvement of your office in this situation since we feel that many in nocent people. Including the elderly, were victimized by Ameritech." Ellan said her company never promised to keep the economy rates at a certain price for any length of time. "The service agreement clear-ly states that the rates are subject to change," she said.

CUSTOMERS AILEN'T locked into any commitment with Ameri-tech, but rather with the dealers who sold them the phones, Elian stressed. Dealers, she said, often sell cellu-lar phones below cost and make their profits on the commission Am-eritech gives them for each new cus-tumer.

tomer. However, Ameritech requires the However, Ameritech requires the customers to creania customers for a certain length of time before paying out the dealers' commissions. So dealers, Ellan said, sign customers for varying lengths of time. That's the only way dealers can alford to sell cellular phones below cost, Elian said.

According to Elian, the equipment agreement with Metro-Cell keeps Kadian tied to Ameritech.
