of old glass can be difficult to match. Modern repairs to old glass, there-fore, are likely to be costly and are not always an aesthetic improve-ment ment.

ment. "My recommendation to people with windows they think might need to be repaired is to do the mini-mum," asy Wilson. If the glass rat-tles in its leading, Wilson recom-mends applying ordinary glazing putty between the glass and the lead rather than releading the window — an expensive job.

IF THERE ARE concerns about future window damage or energy loss around loose leading, install clear-glass windows on the outside and-or inside of the stained glass.

If the solder joints between the pleces of stalned glass are cracked, however, the window should be ei-ther replaced or professionally re-
