

# Prosecutor to seek \$75,000 for grand juries

Oakland County commissioners will be asked to come up with

\$75,000 to finance the two grand juries that will be sitting simultaneously to continue the probe into drug trafficking.  
Prosecutor Richard Thompson

said he will request the money in the immediate future, possibly at today's meeting of the finance committee of the Oakland County Board of Commissioners.

Seeking the money became a necessity after judges of the Oakland County Circuit Court Tuesday approved a request from Thompson asking for the two grand juries.  
JUDGES SPECIFICALLY approved extending the term of the grand jury that has been sitting since September and empanelling a second grand jury, possibly within 30 days. Judges granted Thompson's request after an hourlong meeting at which the prosecutor used a video


tape and other means to present information justifying what was considered an unusual request.  
In February when Thompson made his requests, Chief Judge Steven Andrews said the prosecutor would have to be "very persuasive" to convince judges that two grand juries are needed simultaneously.  
Andrews also predicted judges would need to know why the same results couldn't be achieved through normal investigative channels in-

stead of the grand juries.  
Andrews was not available after Tuesday's meeting.  
Thompson, however, said the success of the existing grand jury very likely had a positive impact on the judges. "I can't tell you what I said (most proceedings concerning the grand jury are secret).  
"But the grand jury has indicted 24 people on drug-related charges, five people for murder and one for perjury," Thompson said.
