"Tools for Personal Success" is the title of an eight-hour program designed for evaluating self-esteem scheduled to begin May 10 on the Orchard Ridge Campus of Oakland Community College. Instructor for the program is Sue Serlin, of Sue Serlin Enterprises, who received her bachelor's degree in education from the National College of Education in Chicago and has worked in the counseling field for 18 years. She is a past president of the Michigan Association for Children with Learning Disabilities. Classified as dyslexic, Serlin overcame her own disability and in the course of her growth developed techniques to expose her inner self. "My program helps people get to their subconscious and find out why they are not getting what they want out of life," Serlin said. "Participants have creative fun while learning the powerful techniques for accelerating confidence and experiencing inner healing and peace, gentle growth, harmony and balance."
