



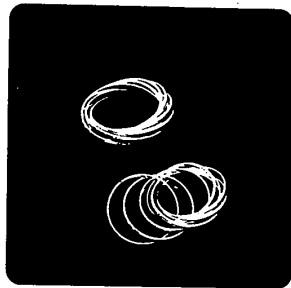
SHELLY CIMMER

A recent ceremony in B'nai B'rith, Southfield, joined Renee Sharon Berlin and Ronald Gene Zack in marriage.

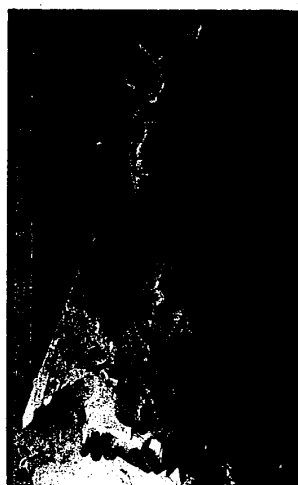
Parents of the couple are Mr. and Mrs. Louis Berlin of Southfield and Mr. and Mrs. Samuel N. Zack of Farmington.

Write-In Campaign Is Urged

No-Phosphate Detergent Now On Sale

A no-phosphate, bio-degradable laundry detergent is being marketed by Montgomery Ward stores, including the Wonderland Center outlet.

The result of years of research, the laundry product is white and has a fresh floral scent and contains sodium perborate for deeper stain-removing action, according to Ward officials. It will be equally effective in hot or cold water.

The product was developed by Standard T Chemicals, a Ward subsidiary, to aid in the water pollution war that is aggravated by phosphates in laundry detergents feeding algae in lakes and streams.

The new product's bio-degradable qualities allows it to decompose easily in sewer systems. A 20-pound carton will sell for \$5, store officials said.
