She recently became a member of Sigma Alpha Iota, a professional music society for women.

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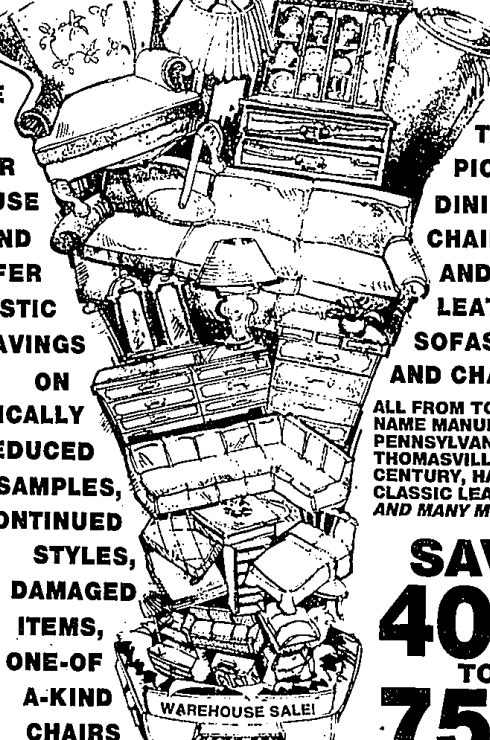
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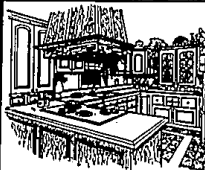
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
