Too little dopamine in the brain results in depress-sion and muscular rigidity. The Natural Resource Commis-sion recently authorized raising the minimum size limit on trout and saimon from eight to 16 inches and reducing the daily possession limit from 10 to three frout or saimon in any combination.
