

Clevers is Realtor of Year

Ruth Clevers, vice president and sales manager for Ralph Manuel Associates-West, Inc., in Farmington Hills, has been named Realtor of the Year by the 2500-member Western Wayne Oakland Association of Realtors (WWOCAR).

The largest Realtor board in Michigan, WWOCAR covers a 1,600 square mile area encompassing Northwest Detroit and major portions of Wayne and Oakland Counties.

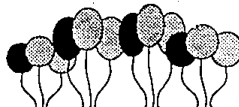
