

Homearama family affair for builders

The fall Homearama near Brighton is a family affair for Jim, Janet and Christopher Compo, principals of a Farmington Hills building firm. The three have a hand in two of the 10 luxury "idea homes" on display at the fall Homearama in the Pine Creek Ridge subdivision, south of Brighton Road and a mile west of Grand River.

The houses, priced at \$500,000 to \$875,000, will be open from 3 p.m. to 10 p.m. Monday through Friday, and noon to 10 p.m. Saturday and Sunday through Oct. 28.

James D. Compo, a Farmington Hills resident and president of the company that bears his name, has been in the building business more

than 30 years. Janet Compo, Compo's wife and a vice president of the company, is involved in architectural design and interior decoration in the houses. She was the first woman to receive the Builder of the Year Award from the Builders Association of Southeast Michigan.

Christopher Compo, a Northville resident, is also a vice president of the company.

Surplus food offered to needy residents

Surplus food will be given out from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Tuesday, Oct. 23, at St. Alexander's Church, 27835 Shilawasse, Farmington Hills.

The food, distributed through the Oakland Living Human Service Agency, includes canned vegetables, beans, flour, cornmeal and butter.

Eligible Oakland County residents should bring the following information to register for the Surplus Commodity Food Program: Social Security card, proof of income for the past 90 days and personal identification. All income eligible Oakland Coun-

ty residents must register prior to the distribution of commodities foods.

If you are homebound and a senior citizen (60 years and over), you should call the senior center nearest your home to register for home-bound delivery. If you do not know which senior center to call, you may call OLHSA's toll free number 1-800-482-9350.

Registration does not guarantee receipt of commodity food each time. Distribution is on a first-come, first-served basis.
