On the outside, the resplendent national headquarters building of the Episcopal Church at 815 Second Ave. in New York looks lively indeed.

Behind a plate glass windown, the church-subsidized Seabury Press has a book store which is offering such stimulating publicationsas: "The Wit and Wisdom of Mac West". "The Black Panthers Speak" and "Selected Works of Mao Tse Tung."

Inside the \$5 million building — which was completed only seven years ago but on which a half million dollars is still owed — the atmosphere approximates an amalgam of babtioir and mansoleum.

The reason: 50 per cent of the 216 headquarters staff have been terminated, due to an unprecedented financial crisis in reduction of support of the national church program by the various dioceses.
