## She Promotes Art And Artists

**SHE PRACTICES** her ideas through a home filled with a fascinating array of art objects, through a weekly column on art in the Southfield News and Observer, and through hard work on the Southfield Arts Council.

But for Ilona Weissman, the kind of art promotion she does so well found its start with the realization that she herself wasn't as good an artist as she might have wished.

"I was always in art activities," she said. "I majored in art at college and taught elementary school in Ferndale, at the same time painting and working in other media and doing all the things that good artists do."

"But somewhere along the way I realized I wasn't really a very good artist."

So promotion seemed the proper course for the young teacher.

"I STARTED with showing the work of young artists," she recalled. "I put together shows for new home openings and stores."

Eventually she tried renting a hall for a day-long showing of the work of many artists. It went over so well that she decided to open a gallery in the Livorno-Seven Mile area of Detroit.

"I had the gallery three years and it was quite successful," she said. "At first I kept on teaching, but eventually was able to give full time to the gallery."

It was during that time that she organized the Detroit Art Gallery Association, which worked on promotions for art shows and functioned to back up works sold by member galleries.

During the gallery days, too, Ilona became more interested in several art areas more or less new to her - graphics and German expressionism.

## OCC To Sponsor Women's Teach-In

An all-day women's teach-in to celebrate International Women's Day, March 8, will be held on the Orchard Ridge Campus of Oakland Community College.

The OCC Student Activities office will sponsor the program, open to the public and scheduled for room 306 in the J. Building.

The morning program, 9 a.m. to 12 noon, includes workshops in sex roles and a liberated child, alternatives to pregnancy, alternatives to marriage and motherhood, communal living, and radical lesbianism.

**THE AFTERNOON** program, 1 p.m. to 5 p.m., will include workshops on black women at OCC, staff women at OCC, day care at OCC, and how to start a self awareness group.

Other features of the afternoon session include two guerrilla theatre presentations conducted by the Detroit Women's Media Cooperative, a group of 25 writers in the field of women's rights, and two dance awareness workshops at 2 and 3 p.m. led by Harriet Berg from the Jewish Community Center.
